**HEBER HOLIDAY OPENING NIGHT PREMIERE FILM
AT FOURSITE FILM FESTIVAL**

McKay Daines romantic comedy feature film *Heber Holiday*, shot in Utah, will be the opening night premiere film at the 5th Foursite Film Festival March 5-8. After a gala reception for the festival the film will screen March 5th in Ogden at 8pm at both the famous Peery's Egyptian Theatre on Washington Blvd., and the Megaplex 13 at Junction. McKay Daines will introduce the film at each screening and stars from the film scheduled to attend include, KC Clyde, Jimmy Chunga, Michael Birkeland, Jodi Russell and Thurl Bailey. The Executive Director of the film festival Scott Halford is excited *Heber Holiday* is opening the festival, "The film showcases the best Utah talent in the film industry. It is funny, uplifting and everyone seems to love it, especially after Lindsey Lohan and now Eve Mendes have spent some rehab time in our state."

The plot for the film is ripped out of today's headlines as it follows the story of a fictional out of control actress Sierra Young who is sent by her producer and controlling mother to a rehab clinic in the mountains of Utah. When the actress escapes to the town of Heber she joins the cast of a play incognito and meets wonderful people who change her life for the better. The film won the Best Feature Film Audience Award at the Temecula International Film Festival in California October 2007 and recently won a Bronze Medal of Excellence at the Park City Film and Music Festival January 2008.

Inspired by his life long love of the classic film *Roman Holiday*, McKay Daines, co-wrote the script with his brother Cameron Daines, and directed the film shot in many Utah locations. The film stars Torrey DeVitto (*One Tree Hill*, *Beautiful People* TV series) as Sierra Young and KC Clyde (*The Dance*, *The Best Two Years*) as Tyler, the Yale drama graduate student who returns to Heber to restore his families playhouse. Erin Chambers (*The Singles 2nd Ward*) also stars as the "romantic girl next door" who runs the playhouse and is in love with Tyler. Actor and radio personality Jimmy Chunga (101.9 The End, *Forever Strong*) plays private investigator Hound, and Michael Birkeland, stand up comedian and actor (*The Home Teachers*), stars as wannabe filmmaker who realizes Sierra Young's true identity and secretly films a documentary for tabloid TV. Other stars include Jodi Russell (*Reflections in the Mud*) as Sierra's controlling mother, and basketball star, actor and Jazz commentator, Thurl Bailey.

Triomphe Communications INC produced the film in association with Flynn-Daines Productions LLC., and is in pre-production on the suspense comedy *Return of the Ripper*, written by McKay Daines and Jimmy Chunga and will be produced and directed by McKay Daines, and *Dear John* written by Craig Clyde and Marsha Cook, and will star KC Clyde and be directed by McKay Daines.
